INSURANCE (Russell Bucco)

1. During a training session, one of our volunteers sustained an injury to his knee. This incident was promptly documented to ensure proper record-keeping and follow-up. A formal report detailing the injury was prepared. To comply with organizational procedures and legal requirements, a copy of this report was sent via email to the workman's compensation insurance provider for their records. At present, no medical attention has been sought for the injury, and no further actions have been taken beyond the initial report.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS: (James Lauro)

1. Ciaglia Landscaping provided spring clean-up services. Their work helped prepare the property for the upcoming season by removing debris and refreshing the landscape and fertilizing the grounds.
2. Guardian Protection Services was required to perform repairs on two specific items: the key fob and the doorbell. Their technicians addressed both issues during their visit, ensuring that the key fob and doorbell were restored to proper working conditions. Guardian Protection Services is scheduled to return and complete the installation of a keypad. This keypad will allow everyone to use a combination to access the door, enhancing security and convenience for all individuals who require entry.
3. The Department of Motor Vehicle utilized our parking lot to conduct the renewal process for upcoming inspection stickers on vehicles.
4. Tennant Preventive scheduled to come in to do maintenance on the floor scrubber.

JOINT DISTRICT TRAINING GROUNDS (James Lauro)

1. The balance in the checking account as of March 31, 2026, is \$10,948.15.
2. We have placed an order for six Padgenite Panels from WHP. These panels are intended for use on the training grounds. The expected delivery timeframe for Padgenite Panels is approximately six weeks.

DISTRICT CHIEF (Robert DeBold)

1. Car #503 encountered difficulties during the registration renewal process. The main issue stemmed from the omissions, which prevented successful renewal. After reviewing the situation, the DMV advised that the vehicle should be driven and subsequently returned for another inspection.
2. Bayshore Fire & Safety conducted an SBA Hydro test. This procedure was carried out to ensure safety standards and compliance.
